All puppies must be current on vaccinations, including Bordetella and at least two rounds of Distemper/Parvo.



Puppies 16 weeks and older must also have a current rabies vaccination.

Promotes stable temperament and confidence: Early socialization helps puppies develop into well-adjusted adults by reducing fear-based responses and building confidence in new people, environments, and experiences.



Prevents behavioral issues: Structured exposure during critical developmental stages decreases the likelihood of future aggression, anxiety, and reactivity, resulting in more reliable and manageable behavior.



Develops appropriate play and bite inhibition: Supervised, age-appropriate play with other puppies—especially “rough and tumble” interactions—teaches essential social boundaries, including bite inhibition and how to use a gentle mouth.



Enhances adaptability and social skills: Socialized puppies are better equipped to navigate unfamiliar situations and interact appropriately with both humans and other dogs, supporting safer, more positive lifelong relationships.
